## ABSTRACTS

The scientific program of the Conference will include oral and e-poster presentations. All interested parties are invited to submit an abstract of their paper or their research by e-mail no later than **17 June 2015**.

Abstracts must be submitted online **ONLY** via the conference website.

**Note:** Abstracts submitted by fax or e-mail without using the electronic submission form will NOT be accepted.

You are kindly requested to study carefully the instructions for preparation and submission, in order to proceed to "proper submission" of abstracts.

Those wishing to present oral or poster presentations are invited to submit an abstract of their paper.

**Abstracts should be submitted ONLY electronically via the conference website.**

### Instructions for Preparation and Submission of Abstract

To submit your abstract, please, read the instructions carefully and then choose the Electronic Abstract Submission Form.

### PREPARATION

- **The summary must be submitted in the English language.**
- The Online Abstract Submission Form should be completed by the author who will be responsible for all related communication.
- **Size:** The content of the abstract should not exceed 250 words. In case of submission of table / chart / image the text should not exceed 200 words.
- **Table:** Only one table / diagram / picture can be included in each abstract. Its size will correspond to 50 words (and must be calculated within the limit of 250 words of the abstract, in order to adjust in an A4 size paper). It must be stored in image file format (jpeg, gif, etc) to be attached (otherwise cannot be attached). In the printed version, it will be displayed at the end of the page.
- **Structure:** The structure of the abstract should consist of:
  - o Introduction - Purpose
  - o Material / Method
  - o Results
  - o Conclusions

The final format will not include paragraphs separation.

- **Title:** The title of the abstract must be in uppercase characters. Please do not use abbreviations (beyond the ones scientifically used). The title should not exceed 25 words.

## ABSTRACTS

• **Institutions of Origin:** This field should display the Institution/s of Origin of every author (Department / Hospital / University / Institution etc). Please, use numbering for associating every author to their Institution of origin. Each Institution of Origin will be recorded only once (it should not be repeated separately for each author). Should a writer work for more than one Institutions, please use more than one number (e.g. Papadopoulos 1,2)

• **Authors:** The authors' names should be written in lowercase letters with the first letter of the name and full last name. (e.g. G. Papadopoulos).

### ON-LINE ABSTRACT SUBMISSION

• Before submitting your abstract, check for errors or omissions. If accepted, the abstract will be published exactly as submitted. After receiving the abstract -in case of correction, change, addition or subtraction- you should contact the PCO before expiration date for abstract submission.

• Please, do not submit multiple copies of the same abstract. Avoid repeat abstract submission to replace the previous one without first informing the PCO.

### ASSESSMENT

The final classification in topics and the final mode of presentation of accepted papers will be determined by the relevant Scientific Committee after evaluation. With regard to the mode of presentation of papers, the wish of the authors and the organizational needs of the Congress will be taken into consideration. The Scientific Committee reserves the right to reject a paper if it does not meet the above conditions.

### Registration Confirmation

Immediately after the online submission of your abstract, you will receive to your e-mail address an automated reply message confirming the Proper Submission of your abstract.

If you do not receive your confirmation e-mail, you must resubmit your abstract (as this would mean invalid form submission and no registration in the data base) or contact the PCO to solve the problem.

**Acceptance letter** The authors will be notified of the acceptance or rejection of their work and all relevant information for the presentation with a letter of acceptance sent electronically on 07/07/2015.

### Important notes

1. Registration payment of at least one of the abstract's authors is a prerequisite for the abstract to be included in the Scientific Program/Book of Abstracts and presented in the Congress printed material. 2. Abstracts must be authentic and original. Papers that have been previously published will not be accepted.
