## NICOLA'S FOUNDATION

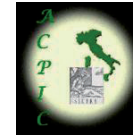
The institutional aims of the Foundation are:

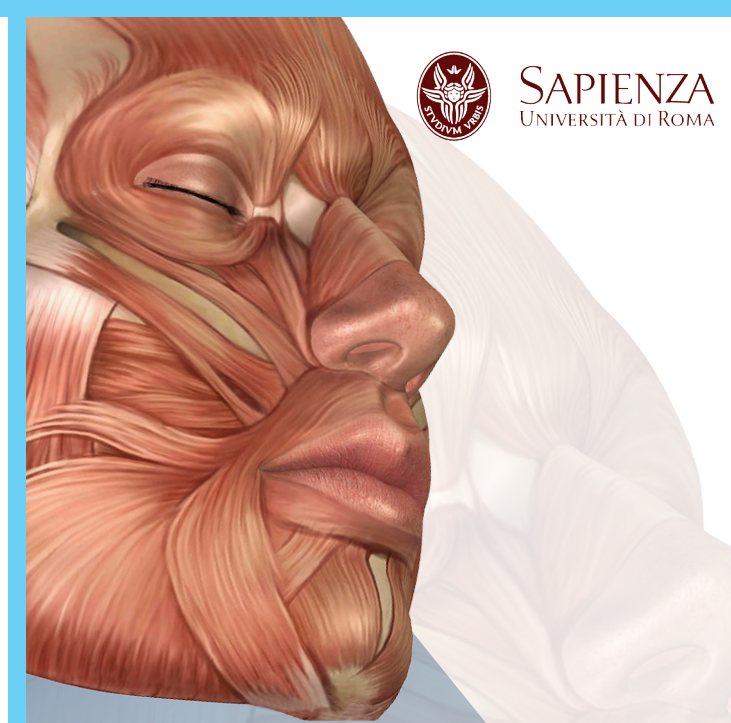
